A PARTNERSHIP INVOLVES TWO OR MORE INDIVIDUALS WHO AGREE TO CARRY ON A BUSINESS TOGETHER. PARTNERSHIPS CAN BE GENERAL OR LIMITED, WITH VARYING DEGREES OF PERSONAL LIABILITY. A FORMAL PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT IS RECOMMENDED TO OUTLINE THE TERMS OF THE PARTNERSHIP.

LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY (LLC)

AN LLC COMBINES THE FLEXIBILITY OF A PARTNERSHIP WITH THE LIABILITY PROTECTION OF A CORPORATION. OWNERS, KNOWN AS MEMBERS, ARE TYPICALLY NOT PERSONALLY LIABLE FOR BUSINESS DEBTS. THIS STRUCTURE IS POPULAR FOR SMALL BUSINESSES DUE TO ITS SIMPLICITY AND TAX ADVANTAGES.

CORPORATION

A CORPORATION IS A MORE COMPLEX BUSINESS STRUCTURE THAT IS LEGALLY SEPARATE FROM ITS OWNERS. CORPORATIONS OFFER THE STRONGEST PROTECTION FROM PERSONAL LIABILITY, BUT THEY REQUIRE MORE EXTENSIVE RECORD-KEEPING, OPERATIONAL PROCESSES, AND REGULATORY COMPLIANCE.

MAINTAINING GOOD STANDING WITH THE MAINE BUSINESS REGISTRY

ONCE A BUSINESS IS REGISTERED, IT IS ESSENTIAL TO MAINTAIN ITS GOOD STANDING WITH THE MAINE BUSINESS REGISTRY. THIS CAN BE ACHIEVED THROUGH VARIOUS MEANS, INCLUDING:

ANNUAL REPORTS

PAYING FEES AND TAXES
