UNDERSTANDING COLOR CHEMISTRY

IN ORDER TO GRASP THE ESSENCE OF COLOR CHEMISTRY, ONE MUST CONSIDER THE ROLES OF PIGMENTS, DYES, AND OTHER COLORANTS. PIGMENTS ARE TYPICALLY INSOLUBLE PARTICLES THAT CAN ABSORB LIGHT AND ARE USED IN PAINTS AND INKS, WHILE DYES ARE USUALLY SOLUBLE AND ARE OFTEN USED IN TEXTILES AND FOOD. THIS PHENOMENON IS DESCRIBED BY THE PRINCIPLES OF QUANTUM MECHANICS AND IS FOUNDATIONAL TO UNDERSTANDING COLOR CHEMISTRY.

TYPES OF COLORANTS

COLORANTS CAN BE BROADLY CATEGORIZED INTO TWO MAIN TYPES: PIGMENTS AND DYES. EACH TYPE HAS UNIQUE PROPERTIES AND APPLICATIONS:

THE SCIENCE OF COLOR PERCEPTION

THESE SIGNALS ARE THEN TRANSMITTED TO THE BRAIN, WHICH PROCESSES THEM TO CREATE THE PERCEPTION OF COLOR. THIS INTERACTION BETWEEN LIGHT, THE EYE, AND THE BRAIN IS INFLUENCED BY VARIOUS FACTORS, INCLUDING SURROUNDING COLORS, LIGHTING CONDITIONS, AND INDIVIDUAL DIFFERENCES IN VISION.

COLOR MODELS
