

# EA MEANING CHEMISTRY

## INTRODUCTION TO ELECTRON AFFINITY

## UNDERSTANDING ELECTRON AFFINITY

ELECTRON AFFINITY IS OFTEN EXPRESSED IN KILOJOULES PER MOLE (KJ/MOL) AND CAN BE REPRESENTED MATHEMATICALLY AS FOLLOWS:



IN THIS EQUATION, A REPRESENTS THE ATOM,  $e^{-}$  IS THE ADDED ELECTRON, AND  $A^{-}$  IS THE RESULTING ANION. THE ENERGY RELEASED DURING THIS PROCESS INDICATES THE ATOM'S ELECTRON AFFINITY.

# TYPES OF ELECTRON AFFINITY

THERE ARE TWO PRIMARY TYPES OF ELECTRON AFFINITY:

- **FIRST ELECTRON AFFINITY:** THIS REFERS TO THE ENERGY CHANGE WHEN ONE MOLE OF ELECTRONS IS ADDED TO ONE MOLE OF NEUTRAL ATOMS. IT IS TYPICALLY A NEGATIVE VALUE, INDICATING THAT ENERGY IS RELEASED DURING THE PROCESS.
- **SECOND ELECTRON AFFINITY:** THIS OCCURS WHEN A SECOND ELECTRON IS ADDED TO A NEGATIVELY CHARGED ION. THIS PROCESS IS USUALLY ENDOTHERMIC (POSITIVE VALUE) BECAUSE THE REPULSION BETWEEN THE NEGATIVELY CHARGED ION AND THE INCOMING ELECTRON REQUIRES ENERGY TO OVERCOME.

UNDERSTANDING THESE DISTINCTIONS IS VITAL FOR PREDICTING THE BEHAVIOR OF ELEMENTS IN CHEMICAL REACTIONS.

# FACTORS AFFECTING ELECTRON AFFINITY

SEVERAL FACTORS INFLUENCE THE ELECTRON AFFINITY OF AN ELEMENT, INCLUDING:

- **SUBSHELL CONFIGURATION:** THE ELECTRON CONFIGURATION OF AN ATOM CAN INFLUENCE ITS ELECTRON AFFINITY. ATOMS THAT ARE ONE ELECTRON SHORT OF A FILLED SUBSHELL OFTEN HAVE HIGHER ELECTRON AFFINITIES.

THESE FACTORS INTERACT IN COMPLEX WAYS, MAKING THE PREDICTION OF ELECTRON AFFINITY A NUANCED ASPECT OF CHEMISTRY.

# APPLICATIONS OF ELECTRON AFFINITY
