## TYPES OF MIXTURES

- VARIABLE PROPERTIES DEPENDING ON THE SAMPLE

EXAMPLES OF HETEROGENEOUS MIXTURES INCLUDE:

## EXAMPLES OF MIXTURES

- **PAINT:** A MIXTURE OF PIGMENTS AND SOLVENTS THAT PROVIDES COLOR AND TEXTURE WHILE REMAINING SEPARABLE INTO ITS COMPONENTS.

## REAL-LIFE APPLICATIONS OF MIXTURES
