INTRODUCTION TO NMM CHEMISTRY

- SULFUR (S): KNOWN FOR ITS ROLE IN BIOLOGICAL SYSTEMS AND INDUSTRIAL PROCESSES, SULFUR IS ESSENTIAL FOR SYNTHESIZING CERTAIN AMINO ACIDS.
- PHOSPHORUS (P): AN ESSENTIAL ELEMENT FOR LIFE, PHOSPHORUS IS A KEY COMPONENT OF DNA AND ATP.

EACH OF THESE ELEMENTS PLAYS A CRITICAL ROLE IN VARIOUS CHEMICAL PROCESSES AND APPLICATIONS.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES OF NON-METALS

NON-METALS EXHIBIT A RANGE OF PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES, INCLUDING:

- LOW DENSITY AND LOW MELTING AND BOILING POINTS (WITH EXCEPTIONS SUCH AS CARBON IN ITS DIAMOND FORM).
- HIGH IONIZATION ENERGIES AND ELECTRONEGATIVITIES COMPARED TO METALS.
- VARIED STATES AT ROOM TEMPERATURE: SOME NON-METALS ARE GASES (E.G., NITROGEN, OXYGEN), WHILE OTHERS ARE SOLIDS (E.G., SULFUR, PHOSPHORUS).
- REACTIVITY VARIES WIDELY AMONG NON-METALS; FOR INSTANCE, HALOGENS ARE HIGHLY REACTIVE, WHILE NOBLE GASES ARE MOSTLY INERT.

THESE PROPERTIES SIGNIFICANTLY INFLUENCE HOW NON-METALS INTERACT WITH OTHER ELEMENTS AND COMPOUNDS.

REACTIONS INVOLVING NON-METALS
