MEDICAL APPLICATIONS OF NUCLEAR CHEMISTRY

- **IODINE-131:** EMPLOYED IN THYROID IMAGING AND TREATMENT OF THYROID DISORDERS.

TREATMENT OF DISEASES

NUCLEAR CHEMISTRY ALSO PLAYS A CRUCIAL ROLE IN THERAPEUTIC APPLICATIONS, PARTICULARLY IN CANCER TREATMENT. RADIOACTIVE ISOTOPES ARE UTILIZED IN TARGETED RADIOTHERAPY, WHERE THEY DELIVER LOCALIZED RADIATION TO TUMORS WHILE MINIMIZING DAMAGE TO SURROUNDING HEALTHY TISSUES.

SOME NOTABLE TREATMENTS INCLUDE:

ENERGY PRODUCTION THROUGH NUCLEAR CHEMISTRY

- **PRESSURIZED WATER REACTORS (PWR):** USE WATER AS BOTH A COOLANT AND A NEUTRON MODERATOR.
- **BOILING WATER REACTORS (BWR):** GENERATE STEAM DIRECTLY IN THE REACTOR CORE.
- **FAST BREEDER REACTORS:** PRODUCE MORE FISSIONABLE MATERIAL THAN THEY CONSUME, ENHANCING FUEL EFFICIENCY.

NUCLEAR FUSION RESEARCH

WHILE NUCLEAR FISSION IS CURRENTLY THE PREDOMINANT METHOD FOR NUCLEAR ENERGY PRODUCTION, NUCLEAR FUSION IS BEING RESEARCHED AS A POTENTIALLY CLEANER AND MORE SUSTAINABLE ENERGY SOURCE. FUSION REACTIONS, WHICH OCCUR IN THE SUN, INVOLVE COMBINING LIGHT ATOMIC NUCLEI TO FORM HEAVIER NUCLEI, RELEASING ENERGY IN THE PROCESS.

EFFORTS SUCH AS THE ITER PROJECT AIM TO DEVELOP FUSION TECHNOLOGY THAT COULD PROVIDE A NEAR-LIMITLESS SUPPLY OF ENERGY WITHOUT THE LONG-LIVED RADIOACTIVE WASTE ASSOCIATED WITH FISSION.

ENVIRONMENTAL APPLICATIONS OF NUCLEAR CHEMISTRY

NUCLEAR CHEMISTRY ALSO CONTRIBUTES SIGNIFICANTLY TO ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE, PARTICULARLY IN AREAS SUCH AS RADIOACTIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING, AND POLLUTION CONTROL.
