

WHAT IS IN SITU IN CHEMISTRY

WHAT IS IN SITU IN CHEMISTRY IS A TERM THAT REFERS TO PROCESSES OR REACTIONS THAT OCCUR IN THEIR ORIGINAL PLACE OR SITE WITHOUT THE NEED FOR EXTRACTION OR ALTERATION.
