UNDERSTANDING AVERAGE TOTAL COST (ATC)

CALCULATION OF ATC

- $ATC = \text{Total Cost} / \text{Quantity of Output}$

VARIABLE COSTS

- SET PRICES ABOVE AVERAGE TOTAL COSTS TO MAXIMIZE PROFITS
- ANALYZE COMPETITOR PRICING STRATEGIES

- EVALUATE POTENTIAL MERGERS OR ACQUISITIONS BASED ON COST SYNERGIES
