HISTORY AND ORIGINS

THE ROOTS OF TRICKLE-DOWN ECONOMICS CAN BE TRACED BACK TO THE MID-20TH CENTURY, GAINING PROMINENCE DURING THE REAGAN ADMINISTRATION IN THE 1980S. CORE PRINCIPLES OF TRICKLE DOWN ECONOMICS

ECONOMIC GROWTH AND CONSUMER BENEFITS

THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF TRICKLE-DOWN ECONOMICS IS TO ACHIEVE BROAD-BASED ECONOMIC GROWTH. BY FOSTERING AN ENVIRONMENT WHERE THE WEALTHY THRIVE, THE THEORY SUGGESTS THAT THE BENEFITS WILL NATURALLY FLOW TO LOWER-INCOME INDIVIDUALS THROUGH INCREASED EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES, HIGHER WAGES, AND GREATER ACCESS TO GOODS AND SERVICES.

CRITICISM OF TRICKLE DOWN ECONOMICS

DESPITE ITS THEORETICAL APPEAL, TRICKLE-DOWN ECONOMICS HAS FACED SUBSTANTIAL CRITICISM FROM VARIOUS ECONOMISTS, POLICYMAKERS, AND SOCIAL ADVOCATES. CRITICS ARGUE THAT THE THEORY DOES NOT HOLD UP IN PRACTICE AND THAT THE BENEFITS DO NOT ADEQUATELY REACH THOSE AT THE BOTTOM OF THE ECONOMIC LADDER.

EVIDENCE FROM ECONOMIC STUDIES
