How PPP is MEASURED

MEASURING PURCHASING POWER PARITY INVOLVES COMPARING THE PRICES OF A BASKET OF GOODS AND SERVICES ACROSS DIFFERENT COUNTRIES. THE FOLLOWING STEPS OUTLINE THE PROCESS OF CALCULATING PPP:

1. **SELECTION OF GOODS AND SERVICES:** A STANDARDIZED BASKET OF GOODS AND SERVICES IS SELECTED, REPRESENTING TYPICAL CONSUMPTION PATTERNS IN THE COUNTRIES BEING COMPARED.

4. **CALCULATION OF PPP:** THE RELATIVE PRICE LEVELS ARE ANALYZED TO DETERMINE THE PPP EXCHANGE RATE, INDICATING HOW MUCH OF ONE CURRENCY IS NEEDED TO PURCHASE THE EQUIVALENT BASKET IN ANOTHER CURRENCY.

THIS METHOD PROVIDES A MORE STABLE AND RELIABLE MEASURE OF CURRENCY VALUE OVER TIME, AS IT REFLECTS ACTUAL PURCHASING POWER RATHER THAN SPECULATIVE EXCHANGE RATES.

ADVANTAGES OF USING PPP

THERE ARE SEVERAL ADVANTAGES TO USING PURCHASING POWER PARITY AS A MEASURE IN ECONOMICS:

DISADVANTAGES OF PPP
