## SURJECTIVE MAPPINGS

SURJECTIVE MAPPINGS, OR ONTO MAPPINGS, ENSURE THAT EVERY ELEMENT IN THE CODOMAIN IS COVERED BY THE MAPPING FROM THE DOMAIN. ## BIJECTIVE MAPPINGS

BIJECTIVE MAPPINGS COMBINE THE PROPERTIES OF INJECTIVE AND SURJECTIVE MAPPINGS. IN A BIJECTIVE MAPPING, EVERY ELEMENT IN THE DOMAIN MAPS TO A UNIQUE ELEMENT IN THE CODOMAIN, AND EVERY ELEMENT IN THE CODOMAIN IS COVERED. THIS TYPE OF MAPPING ESTABLISHES A PERFECT ONE-TO-ONE CORRESPONDENCE BETWEEN THE TWO SETS, MAKING IT PARTICULARLY USEFUL IN CREATING INVERTIBLE FUNCTIONS.

## PROPERTIES OF MAPPINGS

## INVERSE MAPPINGS

INVERSE MAPPINGS ARE VITAL IN SOLVING EQUATIONS AND UNDERSTANDING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN VARIABLES.

## IDENTITY MAPPING

THE IDENTITY MAPPING IS A SPECIAL CASE OF MAPPINGS WHERE EVERY ELEMENT IN A SET MAPS TO ITSELF. DENOTED AS  $\text{id}: A \rightarrow A$ , FOR EVERY ELEMENT  $a$  IN SET  $A$ ,  $\text{id}(a) = a$ . IDENTITY MAPPINGS SERVE AS THE FOUNDATION FOR UNDERSTANDING OTHER TYPES OF MAPPINGS, ESPECIALLY IN LINEAR ALGEBRA.

## APPLICATIONS OF MAPPINGS
