ACADEMIA

PROFESSORS AND RESEARCHERS AT UNIVERSITIES OFTEN LEAD RESEARCH PROJECTS, PUBLISH PAPERS, AND MENTOR STUDENTS. THEY MAY FOCUS ON THEORETICAL OR EXPERIMENTAL ASPECTS OF NUCLEAR PHYSICS, CONTRIBUTING TO THE ADVANCEMENT OF KNOWLEDGE IN THE FIELD.

GOVERNMENT AND NATIONAL LABORATORIES

ANOTHER PROMINENT AVENUE IS WORKING FOR GOVERNMENT AGENCIES OR NATIONAL LABORATORIES. INDUSTRY

THE SKILLS ACQUIRED IN NUCLEAR PHYSICS CAN ALSO BE APPLIED TO ROLES IN SAFETY AND REGULATORY COMPLIANCE, PARTICULARLY CONCERNING NUCLEAR MATERIALS.
