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UNDERSTANDING HEAT PUMPS

THE BASIC OPERATION OF A HEAT PUMP CAN BE LIKENED TO THAT OF A REFRIGERATOR, WHICH REMOVES HEAT FROM ITS INTERIOR AND EXPELS IT OUTSIDE. THE SCIENCE BEHIND HEAT PUMPS

PRESSURE, TRANSFORMING IT INTO A LOW-PRESSURE GAS.

COMPRESSION

THE GASEOUS REFRIGERANT THEN ENTERS THE COMPRESSOR, WHERE IT IS SUBJECTED TO HIGH PRESSURE. THIS COMPRESSION RAISES THE TEMPERATURE OF THE REFRIGERANT SIGNIFICANTLY. THE COMPRESSOR IS A CRITICAL COMPONENT, AS IT ENSURES THAT THE REFRIGERANT FLOWS THROUGH THE SYSTEM AND MAINTAINS THE PRESSURE NEEDED FOR EFFICIENT HEAT TRANSFER.

CONDENSATION

NEXT, THE HIGH-PRESSURE GAS MOVES TO THE CONDENSER COIL, WHERE IT RELEASES THE ABSORBED HEAT TO THE INDOOR SPACE OR WATER. AS THE REFRIGERANT LOSES HEAT, IT CONDENSES BACK INTO A LIQUID STATE. THIS PROCESS INVOLVES THE TRANSFER OF HEAT FROM THE REFRIGERANT TO THE AIR OR WATER, PROVIDING WARMTH TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

EXPANSION

TYPES OF HEAT PUMPS

- **WATER-SOURCE HEAT PUMPS:** THESE SYSTEMS DRAW HEAT FROM A BODY OF WATER, SUCH AS A LAKE OR POND. THEY ARE EFFICIENT AND CAN BE EFFECTIVE IN SPECIFIC GEOGRAPHICAL AREAS WHERE WATER SOURCES ARE ACCESSIBLE.
