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INTRODUCTION TO INTERSTELLAR PHYSICS

THE NATURE OF INTERSTELLAR MATTER

THERMAL BALANCE OF THE ISM.

- **Cosmic Rays:** HIGH-ENERGY PARTICLES THAT TRAVEL THROUGH SPACE AT NEARLY THE SPEED OF LIGHT, COSMIC RAYS ARE THOUGHT TO ORIGINATE FROM SUPERNOVAE AND OTHER ENERGETIC ASTROPHYSICAL PROCESSES.

THESE COMPONENTS INTERACT IN VARIOUS WAYS, LEADING TO PHENOMENA SUCH AS STAR FORMATION, THE PROPAGATION OF RADIATION, AND THE DYNAMICS OF GALAXIES.

PHYSICAL CONDITIONS IN THE INTERSTELLAR MEDIUM

THE PHYSICAL CONDITIONS WITHIN THE ISM CAN VARY WIDELY. TEMPERATURE, DENSITY, AND PRESSURE ARE CRITICAL FACTORS THAT INFLUENCE THE BEHAVIOR OF INTERSTELLAR MATTER. GRAVITY

ELECTROMAGNETIC FORCES

PRESSURE GRADIENTS

STAR FORMATION AND EVOLUTION

THIS INTRICATE PROCESS IS FUNDAMENTAL TO THE EVOLUTION OF GALAXIES AND THE CHEMICAL ENRICHMENT OF THE UNIVERSE AS STARS PRODUCE HEAVIER ELEMENTS THROUGH FUSION.

THE ROLE OF BLACK HOLES

BLACK HOLES PLAY A CRITICAL ROLE IN GALAXY FORMATION AND EVOLUTION, AFFECTING THE MOTION OF STARS AND THE DISTRIBUTION OF INTERSTELLAR MATTER.

DARK MATTER AND DARK ENERGY
