- STRONG COMMUNICATION SKILLS, BOTH WRITTEN AND VERBAL

EDUCATIONALLY, A NUCLEAR PHYSICIST TYPICALLY HOLDS A PH.D. IN NUCLEAR PHYSICS OR A CLOSELY RELATED FIELD. ADVANCED DEGREES ARE ESSENTIAL AS THEY PROVIDE THE RIGOROUS TRAINING NEEDED TO CONDUCT INDEPENDENT RESEARCH AND CONTRIBUTE TO THE SCIENTIFIC COMMUNITY. ADDITIONALLY, POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCH EXPERIENCE IS OFTEN BENEFICIAL FOR THOSE LOOKING TO ADVANCE THEIR CAREERS.

WORK ENVIRONMENT AND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

NUCLEAR PHYSICISTS WORK IN VARIOUS ENVIRONMENTS, INCLUDING UNIVERSITIES, GOVERNMENT LABORATORIES, RESEARCH INSTITUTIONS, AND PRIVATE INDUSTRY.
