## CHARACTERISTICS OF PERIODIC MOTION

HIGHER AMPLITUDES INDICATE MORE VIGOROUS MOTION, WHILE SMALLER AMPLITUDES SUGGEST A MORE SUBDUED MOVEMENT.

## 2. PERIOD

THE PERIOD IS THE TIME TAKEN FOR ONE COMPLETE CYCLE OF MOTION. IT IS A CRITICAL FACTOR IN DEFINING THE FREQUENCY OF THE MOTION. THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PERIOD AND FREQUENCY IS GIVEN BY THE FORMULA:  $\text{FREQUENCY} = 1/\text{PERIOD}$ . FOR EXAMPLE, IF A SWING TAKES 2 SECONDS TO COMPLETE A BACK-AND-FORTH MOTION, ITS PERIOD IS 2 SECONDS, AND ITS FREQUENCY WOULD BE 0.5 Hz.

## 3. FREQUENCY

FREQUENCY REFERS TO THE NUMBER OF CYCLES COMPLETED IN A UNIT TIME, USUALLY MEASURED IN HERTZ (Hz). IT IS INVERSELY RELATED TO THE PERIOD, INDICATING HOW OFTEN THE MOTION OCCURS. THIS CHARACTERISTIC IS VITAL IN VARIOUS APPLICATIONS, SUCH AS SOUND, WHERE DIFFERENT FREQUENCIES CORRESPOND TO DIFFERENT PITCHES.

## 4. PHASE

THE PHASE OF PERIODIC MOTION DESCRIBES THE POSITION OF THE OBJECT AT A SPECIFIC POINT IN TIME WITHIN ITS CYCLE. IT IS OFTEN REPRESENTED AS A FRACTION OF THE CYCLE COMPLETED AND CAN HELP IN ANALYZING THE SYNCHRONIZATION OF MULTIPLE PERIODIC MOTIONS.

# TYPES OF PERIODIC MOTION

SHM IS FUNDAMENTAL IN VARIOUS AREAS OF PHYSICS, INCLUDING WAVE MOTION AND OSCILLATIONS.

## 2. DAMPED MOTION

DAMPED MOTION OCCURS WHEN AN EXTERNAL FORCE, SUCH AS FRICTION OR AIR RESISTANCE, GRADUALLY REDUCES THE AMPLITUDE OF THE MOTION OVER TIME. ALTHOUGH THE MOTION REMAINS PERIODIC, THE ENERGY LOSS RESULTS IN A DECREASE IN AMPLITUDE UNTIL THE MOTION EVENTUALLY CEASES. EXAMPLES INCLUDE A SWINGING PENDULUM THAT EVENTUALLY COMES TO REST OR A VIBRATING GUITAR STRING THAT LOSES ITS SOUND.

## 3. FORCED MOTION

FORCED MOTION TAKES PLACE WHEN AN EXTERNAL PERIODIC FORCE IS APPLIED TO A SYSTEM. THIS CAN RESULT IN RESONANCE, WHERE THE SYSTEM VIBRATES AT ITS NATURAL FREQUENCY DUE TO THE EXTERNAL FORCE. AN EXAMPLE WOULD BE PUSHING A SWING AT REGULAR INTERVALS, WHICH CAN INCREASE ITS AMPLITUDE SIGNIFICANTLY. UNDERSTANDING FORCED MOTION IS CRUCIAL IN FIELDS LIKE ENGINEERING AND ACOUSTICS.

# MATHEMATICAL MODELS OF PERIODIC MOTION

A = AMPLITUDE

$\omega$  = ANGULAR FREQUENCY ( $2\pi/T$ )

$\phi$  = PHASE CONSTANT

T = TIME

## 2. ENERGY IN PERIODIC MOTION

ENERGY TRANSFORMATIONS ARE A KEY ASPECT OF PERIODIC MOTION, PARTICULARLY IN SIMPLE HARMONIC MOTION. THE TOTAL MECHANICAL ENERGY IN SHM IS CONSERVED AND CAN BE REPRESENTED AS THE SUM OF KINETIC AND POTENTIAL ENERGY.
