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WHAT IS fMRI PSYCHOLOGY?

How fMRI Works

IMAGING PROCESS

THE PROCESS OF CONDUCTING AN fMRI STUDY TYPICALLY INVOLVES SEVERAL KEY STEPS:

1. **PARTICIPANT PREPARATION:** PARTICIPANTS ARE SCREENED TO ENSURE THEY MEET THE STUDY CRITERIA AND ARE COMFORTABLE WITH THE PROCEDURE.

APPLICATIONS OF fMRI IN PSYCHOLOGY
