WHAT IS GLUTAMATE?

THE BALANCE OF GLUTAMATE IS ESSENTIAL; EXCESSIVE LEVELS CAN LEAD TO EXCITOTOXICITY, DAMAGING NEURONS AND

AFFECTING BRAIN HEALTH. THIS DELICATE BALANCE IS CRUCIAL FOR HEALTHY COGNITIVE FUNCTION AND EMOTIONAL REGULATION.

GLUTAMATE IN THE BRAIN

GLUTAMATE PREDOMINANTLY RESIDES IN THE BRAIN'S SYNAPTIC CLEFTS, WHERE IT FACILITATES COMMUNICATION BETWEEN NEURONS. THIS INTRICATE SYSTEM HIGHLIGHTS HOW GLUTAMATE IS ESSENTIAL NOT ONLY FOR BASIC NEURONAL COMMUNICATION BUT ALSO FOR COMPLEX COGNITIVE PROCESSES.

GLUTAMATE AND COGNITIVE FUNCTIONS
