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## KEY MILESTONES IN THE HISTORY OF PSYCHOLOGY

# THE BIRTH OF MODERN PSYCHOLOGY

PSYCHOLOGY BEGAN TO EMERGE AS A DISTINCT SCIENTIFIC DISCIPLINE IN THE LATE 19TH CENTURY. ### CARL ROGERS AND HUMANISTIC PSYCHOLOGY
