

SENSORY CORTEX PSYCHOLOGY DEFINITION

SENSORY CORTEX PSYCHOLOGY DEFINITION REFERS TO THE PART OF THE BRAIN RESPONSIBLE FOR PROCESSING SENSORY INFORMATION FROM VARIOUS MODALITIES, INCLUDING TOUCH, TASTE, SIGHT, SOUND, AND SMELL. ROLE IN SENSORY PROCESSING

CLINICAL IMPLICATIONS OF SENSORY CORTEX RESEARCH
